Sub: - **17 Junior Engineers resigned from their jobs - requesting to declare these posts as vacant – req.**

Sir,

We wish to bring the following to your kind notice for favour of necessary action.

The issue relates to Jammu & Kashmir circle, where the sanctioned strength of Junior Engineers is 120. Presently, the working strength is being shown as 116. Whereas, 17 Junior Engineers have already resigned from their jobs long back. Despite this, the Jammu & Kashmir circle administration is maintaining that the working strength of the Junior Engineers is 116. This is totally wrong.

The Management has not taken any action to declare the 17 posts of the persons who have already resigned and left BSNL, as vacant. Consequent to this, it was declared that, there was only 1 JE post vacant for the JE LICE conducted in September, 2024. It is needless for us to mention that, the non-declaring of the aforementioned 17 posts as vacant, has adversely affected the promotional prospects of 17 employees in J&K circle.

In view of this, we request that, expeditious action may kindly be taken to declare the 17 posts of the Junior Engineers who have resigned from BSNL, as vacant. These posts may kindly be declared as vacancies for the next JE LICE.
