Immediate tasks before the CEC members – All India Centre and Coordination Committee meeting hold serious discussions.

Comrades,

A serious discussion was held in the All India Centre meeting, which also reviewed the decisions taken by the Central Secretariat meeting. Another important online meeting of the BSNL Coordination Committee was held on 19.06.2026. Several important decisions were taken in both the meetings. All CEC members are requested to give utmost attention to the effective implementation of these decisions and programmes, as detailed below:-

1. **3rd PRC issue:** On the issue of Wage Revision, it has been decided to initiate preparations for a March to Parliament during the forthcoming Monsoon Session, preferably in the last week of July or first week of August. Efforts will be made to secure a decision under AUAB, following which the CoC will take the final call.
2. **Membership Verification:** BSNL Corporate Office has decided to conduct the next Membership Verification without further extension. Though the process for the 10th Membership Verification is yet to be finalised, switchover membership has commenced from 16.06.2026 to 15.07.2026. All CEC members, Circle Secretaries and District Secretaries should maintain close contact with members during this crucial period.
3. **Solidarity Campaign for Cuba:** WFTU and TUI have launched a Digital Signature Campaign in support of Cuba against the economic blockade imposed by US imperialism. BSNLEU will conduct a week-long campaign from 22nd to 27th June, 2026 to mobilise BSNL employees in support of this initiative. Link for Digital Signature is firmoporcuba.com.
4. **National Demand Day – 01.07.2026:** BSNL Management continues to ignore key Non-Executive issues, including relaxation of the Affordability Clause, New Promotion Policy, revision of Perks and Allowances, 30% SAB contribution, LICE, Rule-8/Rule-9 transfers, etc. National Demand Day will be observed on 01.07.2026, and memorandums addressed to CMD BSNL should be submitted through the concerned CGM/GM. A poster on the subject has been dispatched to the district secretaries for the campaign.
5. **CEC Meeting at Vijayawada:** The next CEC meeting will be held at Vijayawada on 05th & 06th July, 2026. Preparations for the CEC meeting are progressing well under the leadership of the Telangana and Andhra Pradesh Circle Unions. Although a few circle unions had initially expressed difficulties in attending, CHQ has requested them to ensure their participation considering the importance of the meeting.
6. **Organisational issues:** Various organisational matters and representations received by CHQ will be discussed in the forthcoming CEC meeting for appropriate decisions.
7. **Immediate Task – Holding BSNL Coordination Committee Meetings:** The BSNL Coordination Committee will issue a separate circular on the decisions taken in its online meeting held on 19.06.2026. Meanwhile, all CEC members, Circle Secretaries and District Secretaries should take immediate steps to organise Coordination Committee meetings at the circle level in consultation with AIBDPA and BSNLCCWF. Circle Secretaries are requested to submit a brief report on the outcome of these meetings in the next CEC.

All CEC members are requested to take necessary initiatives to implement these decisions effectively at the grassroots level.
