Sub: - **Reminder – Request for grant of appointment for discussion on the Wage Revision, Pension Revision and other burning issues of BSNL employees and pensioners – req.**

Sir,

Kindly refer to the letter cited above, whereby the Coordination Committee of BSNL Employees Union (BSNLEU), All India BSNL DoT Pensioners Association (AIBDPA) and BSNL Casual Contract Workers Federation (BSNLCCWF) had requested an appointment with the Secretary, Department of Telecommunications, for submission of a memorandum on the long-pending issues of BSNL employees and pensioners, particularly Wage Revision and Pension Revision, besides other important issues.

However, on the same day, i.e., 07.08.2026, we submitted the memorandum at your office at Sanchar Bhawan and met the officer on duty. We were informed that an appointment with you could not be granted at that time due to your busy schedule in connection with the Parliament Session. We fully understood and accepted the position.
