Dear Comrades,

***Massive March to Parliament on 7th August, 2026,
demanding settlement of Wage Revision and Pension Revision
– Clarion Call of the Coordination Committee.***

The meeting of the Coordination Committee of BSNLEU, AIBDPA and BSNLCCWF, held on 19th June, 2026, decided to organise a phased programme of agitations culminating in the **March to Parliament** programme. BSNLEU and AIBDPA made serious efforts to organise this March to Parliament programme as a joint programme of all the unions and associations. However, despite our best efforts, this could not materialise.

Therefore, the Coordination Committee has decided to go ahead with the **March to Parliament** programme on **7th August, 2026**, to intensify the struggle demanding relaxation of the **Affordability Clause**, thereby paving the way for the settlement of the Wage Revision and Pension Revision issues. This March to Parliament programme assumes great significance, as it is being organised during the Monsoon Session of Parliament. Hence, comrades from all the circles are requested to mobilise the maximum number of participants for this programme.

The March to Parliament will be the culmination of a series of nationwide agitational programmes, including **Demand Day** on **16-07-2026**, a three-day **Dharna** on **22nd, 23rd and 24th July, 2026**, a **Twitter Campaign** on **27th July, 2026**, and other mass mobilisation programmes. All these programmes should be organised successfully by making maximum efforts towards mobilisation.

The struggle assumes even greater significance at this crucial juncture, when the Hon'ble Delhi High Court has quashed the order of the Hon'ble CAT, Delhi, on pension revision based on the 7th CPC fitment. The demand of casual contract labourers will also be highlighted in this March to Parliament programme.


