BSNL Coordination Committee reviews agitation programmes and finalises arrangements for 07th August March to Parliament.

Dear Comrades,

To review the preparations for the March to Parliament programme to be held at New Delhi, on 07th August 2026, an online meeting of the Coordination Committee of BSNLEU, AIBDPA and BSNLCCWF was held on 23.07.2026. The meeting was attended by the following:

BSNLEU: Com.M.Vijayakumar, President, Com.Animesh Mitra, Convenor, CoC & General Secretary and Com.Ganesh Hinge, Deputy General Secretary.

AIBDPA: Com.M.R. Das, President, Com.R. Muraleedharan Nair, General Secretary & Chairman, CoC and Com.K.G. Jayaraj, Deputy General Secretary, NCCPA.

BSNLCCWF: Com.P.Abhimanyu, President and Com.Yusuf Hussain, AGS.

The meeting of the BSNL Coordination Committee was presided over by Com. R. Muraleedharan Nair, Chairman and Com. Animesh Mitra, Convenor, narrated the preparation for the 7th August, March to Parliament programme in details. At the outset, the Committee expressed its satisfaction over the successful demonstration held on 16th July, 2026 and the three-day dharna conducted from 22nd to 24th July 2026 across the country. The Committee highly appreciated the massive participation of regular employees, pensioners, and casual/contract workers in both programmes.

It was also appreciated that all the affiliated organisations have conducted their CEC/Secretariat meetings to discuss the decisions of the BSNL Coordination Committee and to intensify preparations for the March to Parliament on 07th August 2026. After detailed deliberations, the following decisions were taken:

1. **Publicity and Campaign:** The BSNL Coordination Committee will publish a poster from the Headquarters and circulate it to all Circles and Districts for wide publicity. A digital leaflet will also be released next week. Circle and District Unions should translate the leaflet into their respective regional languages and ensure its wide circulation. WhatsApp groups and other social media platforms should be effectively utilised to highlight the issues relating to the Wage Revision, Pension Revision, relaxation of the Affordability Clause, and the demands of contract and casual workers.
2. **Mobilisation and Accommodation:** The Committee finalised a mobilisation target of around 1,200 participants for the March to Parliament on 07th August 2026. Accommodation for BSNLEU has already been arranged in Delhi for the delegates who are coming from different part of the country. BSNLEU and AIBDPA will separately make accommodation arrangements for their respective delegates. Com.Biju will coordinate about the hotel accommodation for AIBDPA delegates arriving from different parts of the country.
3. **Programme Schedule:** The programme will commence sharp at 10.00 a.m. and conclude by 1.00 p.m. Leaders from CITU and Members of Parliament actively associated with trade union and public sector issues will be invited to address the gathering. The BSNL Coordination Committee will also approach Members of Parliament, particularly those supportive of public sector issues, to raise the demands of BSNL employees and pensioners in Parliament during the Monsoon Session.
4. **Food and Expenses:** Around 1,000 food packets will be arranged for the participants to be supplied after the programme. The expenditure towards food, publicity and other organisational arrangements will be shared jointly by BSNLEU and AIBDPA.
5. **Speakers:** In addition to the President and General Secretary of BSNLEU, AIBDPA and BSNLCCWF, Com. John Brittas, MP and Member of COPU, Com. Sudip Dutta, President, CITU, Com. Shivagopal Misra, Secretary Staff Side & President NCCPA and Com. K. G. Jayaraj, Officiating General Secretary, NCCPA, will address the gathering.
6. **Twitter Campaign:** The preparation for the Twitter Campaign scheduled to be held on **27th July 2026** were also reviewed. It was decided to issue separate instructions to the Circle and BA leaders, along with suggested messages to be posted and forwarded to the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications, the Secretary, DoT, and other concerned authorities, to ensure the campaign is carried out in a coordinated and effective manner.
