Sub: - **Reconsideration of the case for continuation of GPF facilities to Shri Ajoy Kumar Singh, TT, Ranchi, Jharkhand Circle – reg.**

Sir,

We wish to bring the following facts to your kind notice for favour of necessary action.

Shri Ajoy Kumar Singh, TT, Jharkhand, as a dependent of the deceased employee, applied for appointment on Compassionate Ground on 01.03.1999. His case was duly considered by the Circle Selection Committee under the Chairmanship of the CGM, Jharkhand Circle, in its meeting held on 22.08.2000, and his appointment was formally approved by the HPC. Accordingly, the office order was issued on 10.11.2000 for his appointment in the Group 'D' category.

It is unfortunate that, although the appointment had been duly approved by the then DoT authorities after observing all the prescribed formalities and the Presidential Order was also issued by the DoT on 06.03.2002, his GPF contribution was converted into EPF deduction by the competent authority in 2007, which is illogical and highly unjust. From the records available in the office, it is clear that his appointment on Compassionate Ground had been approved by the competent authority after completion of all the required formalities under the DoT. However, due to the transition from DoT to BSNL, the formal appointment order was issued after the formation of BSNL.

In these circumstances, it would be highly unjust to treat Shri Ajoy Kumar Singh as a fresh BSNL recruit merely on the ground that his formal appointment order was issued by BSNL, and consequently subject him to EPF instead of GPF. His case had already been considered and approved by the competent DoT authorities before the formation of BSNL.

We therefore earnestly request that the entire case of Shri Ajoy Kumar Singh, TT, may kindly be reconsidered in its proper perspective. Since his appointment on Compassionate Ground was approved through the prescribed DoT procedure before the formation of BSNL, the Presidential Order already issued by the DoT may kindly be recognised as a valid document and his GPF status may be restored / continued accordingly.

We sincerely hope that your kind and active intervention in the matter will ensure justice to Shri Ajoy Kumar Singh, TT, Jharkhand and resolve the long-pending issue.
