**10<sup>th</sup> All India Conference at Guwahati from  
02<sup>nd</sup> to 04<sup>th</sup> April, 2022. Let us conduct it successfully.**

Comrades,

As all of you are aware, the 10th All India Conference of BSNLEU is going to be conducted at Guwahati from 02nd to 04th April, 2022. The Reception Committee of the All India Conference is taking all out efforts to make the Conference a historic success. As has already been intimated, the delegate fee for this All India Conference has been fixed as Rs.1,000/- per delegate / observer.

The CHQ has already printed posters for the All India Conference and the same is already despatched to the district unions. The posters should be displayed prominently, to give wide publicity for our Conference.

The previous All India Conferences were held for 4 days. However, the Guwahati All India Conference will be held only for 3 days. Hence, utmost co-operation from the circle and district secretaries, as well as the delegates and observers is required, to conduct the All India Conference in a disciplined and successful manner.

***It has been observed in the previous All India Conferences that, a good number of the delegates and observers did not attend the Conference, but went out for sight-seeing when the Conference was going on. This is a highly indisciplined behaviour. This cannot be allowed to once again happen in the Guwahati Conference.***

With the view to conduct the forthcoming All India Conference successfully, the All India Union gives the following advisory to the circle and district secretaries, as well as to the delegates and observers.

- (1) The All India Centre has already announced the number of delegates and observers eligible for each circle. Only the number of delegates and observers allotted for each circle, will be allowed in the Conference. No extra delegate or observer will be allowed from any circle, on any account.
- (2) All the circle secretaries are requested to send the names of the delegates and observers who will participate in the All India Conference. This list should be sent to the CHQ on or before 25.03.2022. This is very important and all the circle secretaries are requested to do this without fail.
- (3) The Flag hoisting ceremony will start at 09:00 am on 02.04.2022 and the Conference will be over at 05:00 pm on 04.04.2022. All the delegates and observers coming to the All India Conference are requested to maintain these timings.
- (4) All the delegates and observers are expected to attend the Conference fully. No delegate or observer will be allowed to go out for sight-seeing, when the Conference is in session. If any delegate or observer is found to have gone for sight-seeing during the Conference, he / she will not be allowed into the Conference thereafter.
- (5) Roll call will be taken during the Conference, to find out the absentees.

CHQ requests all the circle and district unions, as well as the delegates and observers to extend their kind co-operation, to conduct the Conference successfully.
