Sub: - **Issuing of Presidential Orders to the Temporary Status Mazdoors, who were directly promoted as Telecom Technicians, without getting regularised as Regular Mazdoors- req.**

We wish to bring the following to your kind notice, for favour of your kind consideration.

As per the DoT order on the issuing of Temporary Status to the casual labourers, 50% of the Temporary Status service is to be counted for pension. Consequent to this order, the DoT decided to issue Presidential Order to all the casual labourers, who were conferred with Temporary Status prior to 29.09.2000 and who were regularised as RMs on or after 01.10.2000. A good number of casual labourers, who fulfilled the above criteria have been issued with Presidential Orders.

However, nearly 400 officials in BSNL who were conferred with Temporary Status prior to 29.09.2000, had directly been promoted as Telecom Technicians, without getting regularised as Regular Mazdoors. Presidential Orders have not been issued to them by the DoT. The argument of the DoT is, Presidential Orders will be issued only to those TSMs who were appointed as RMs.

Based on the Temporary Status Scheme of the DoT, if 50% service rendered as Temporary Status Mazdoor is to be counted for calculation of pension, then Presidential Order should also be issued to the Temporary Status Mazdoors, who were directly promoted as Telecom Technicians. Otherwise, 50% of their TSM service cannot be counted for pension, as has been envisaged in the scheme for the conferment of Temporary Status.

Hence, we earnestly appeal to you sir, to kindly revisit this issue and to ensure that the nearly 400 TSMs who had directly been promoted as Telecom Technicians are also issued with Presidential Orders.
