With reference to the above cited reference, we wish to bring the following to your kind notice for favour of necessary action.

Shri Brijesh Kumar Singh, JE, was transferred under Rule 9 from Himachal Pradesh Circle to UP (West) Circle. His wife is employed in a bank at Moradabad and they have an infant child. In view of these compelling personal circumstances, the official has submitted a representation to the Director (HR) seeking extension of his temporary transfer under Rule 9.

However, it is observed that, upon completion of the tenure period, official is being repatriated to his parent circle on the grounds that the prescribed period of temporary transfer has been completed. In this regard, the concerned official has already submitted representations to the Corporate Office, requesting extension of the temporary transfer on genuine and compassionate grounds.

Further, we would like to draw your kind attention to the discussions held in the Formal Meeting in this regard with the Management, wherein we had requested that extensions may be granted to those officials whose transfers were approved by the Corporate Office under Rule 9 parameters.

The request of the official for extension of the temporary transfer is genuine and merits sympathetic consideration. Moreover, Himachal Pradesh Circle, from where the official was transferred, is a surplus circle in respect of the JE cadre.
