Sub: - **Requesting to completely cancel transfer orders issued in contravention of Corporate Office instructions – case of Assam circle - reg.**

With reference to the letters cited above, we wish to bring the following to your kind notice, for favour of needful action.

The General Manager, Tezpur, Assam circle, vide letter number cited under reference (1), issued transfer orders to five Non-Executives from Nagaon SSA to Tezpur SSA. This transfer order was issued in total violation of the instructions of the Corporate Office on the subject and thus, are arbitrary and high handed. It is important to note that, one of the transferees is Shri Debasis Majumdar, who is the District Secretary of BSNLEU and who is enjoying immunity from transfers, as per the existing Corporate Office instructions.

BSNLEU, vide it's letter cited under reference (2), wrote to the Director (HR), BSNL, protesting against the transfer orders and requested cancellation of the same. Thereafter, the General Manager, Tezpur, issued letter cited under reference (3), keeping all the five transfers under abeyance.

In this regard, we wish to bring to your kind notice that, the transfer orders issued by the General Manager, Tezpur, vide letter cited under reference (1), is in total violation of the instructions of the Corporate Office on the subject. Further, the transfer of BSNLEU's District Secretary, from Nagaon to Tezpur, is untenable and is violative of the Corporate Office instructions granting immunity from transfers, to the office bearers of the Recognised Unions.

In view of the foregoing, we wish to state that, the transfer order issued to the five Non-Executives should be cancelled in toto. It appears that the General Manager, Tezpur, is sticking on to false prestige and does not want to completely cancel the transfer orders. Hence, we request you to kindly intervene in this matter and to render justice to the transferred officials, by ensuring total cancellation of their transfer order. We hope that, needful action would be taken in this regard expeditiously.
