Sub: - **Non-holding of the postponed JE LICE – requesting to hold the exam without further delay - req.**

With reference to our letters cited above, we wish to draw your kind attention to the following, for favour of necessary intervention.

We wish to express our deep anguish over the inordinate delay in holding the JE LICE. This exam, under 50% quota, for the recruitment year 2017-18, was scheduled to be held on 07.04.2019. However, considering our demand that the JE LICE should be held as an '**off-line**' exam, it was postponed. Thereafter, despite our repeated requests, vide letters cited under reference, the Corporate Office has not taken any action to hold the exam.

In this connection, we would like to bring to your kind notice that, the aspirant candidates of the JE LICE are extremely frustrated. We are at loss to understand the inordinate delay in holding the JE LICE. The Management has already announced to hold the JE LICE on 07.04.2019. It was postponed only to change the mode of conducting it, from '**online**' to '**off-line**'. Since, the decision is already taken by the Management to hold the exam as '**off-line**' exam, as per the decision taken in the 37th meeting of the National Council held on 20.11.2018, absolutely there is no justification to delay the exam.

Further, it is also very unfortunate that, the Management has not cared to give any response to all the four letters, as cited in the reference, written by BSNLEU. In view of the foregoing, we request you to kindly make necessary intervention on this matter and to cause to hold the JE LICE under 50% quota, without further delay.
